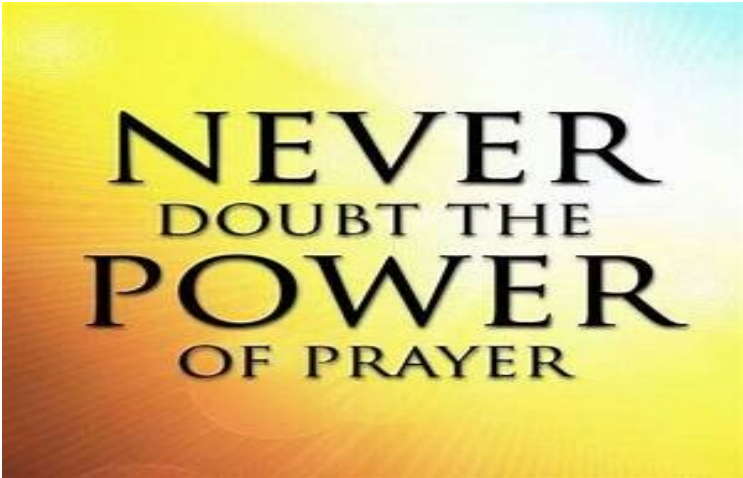

WORSHIP COMMITTEE

The Worship Committee met on Thursday, October 8, 2020. Attendance over all three platforms (in person, livestream, and Facebook) is about the same as it was before the pandemic. We discussed the possibility of congregational singing and getting more people involved in the service (i.e., Elders doing prayers and Communion Meditation). We decided against these items since the COVID-19 numbers are on the rise in Henry County.

THE ORGAN IS INSTALLED! We are so grateful to Keith Sandrock and his crew for installing the new Allen Organ the week of October 5th. We will wait to have a full dedication service and organ concert until the church is fully re-opened so that donors and donor families can attend. Don't forget – if you would like to do so, you still can donate to the cost of the organ.

November 8th is Veterans Day Sunday. We will be showing slides of our veterans during the prelude. The first Sunday of Advent is November 29th. We will be asking folks to light the Advent Wreath all four Sundays and on Christmas Eve.

Christmas Eve will be celebrated with a 9 am to 5 pm “come and go” service and a 5:30 pm full candle-light service. Pre-packaged communion will be served throughout the day, and Pastor Tim will be available from 9 am to 5 pm to bless the communion of those participating during that time. Because of the requirements for distancing during the pandemic, candles will be placed at each available seat for the 5:30 pm service. Pastor Tim will go down the center aisle to light the candles of the first person in each row, and then the light will be passed down the row with everyone staying in their places. That is, we can't form our traditional “Circle of Light,” but we will be lighting up the sanctuary with our individual “Points of Light.”

Additionally, we discussed Pastor Tim taking some time for vacation (he will not be taking any Sundays) and planned the 2021 Worship Committee budget.
