Letter to the Editor from the Clinton Democrat

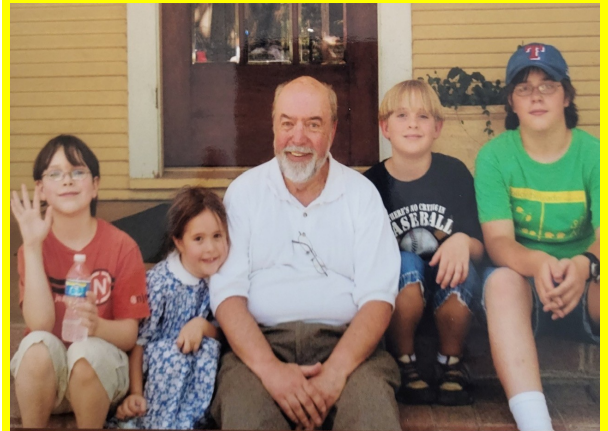
To the Editor and citizens of Clinton,

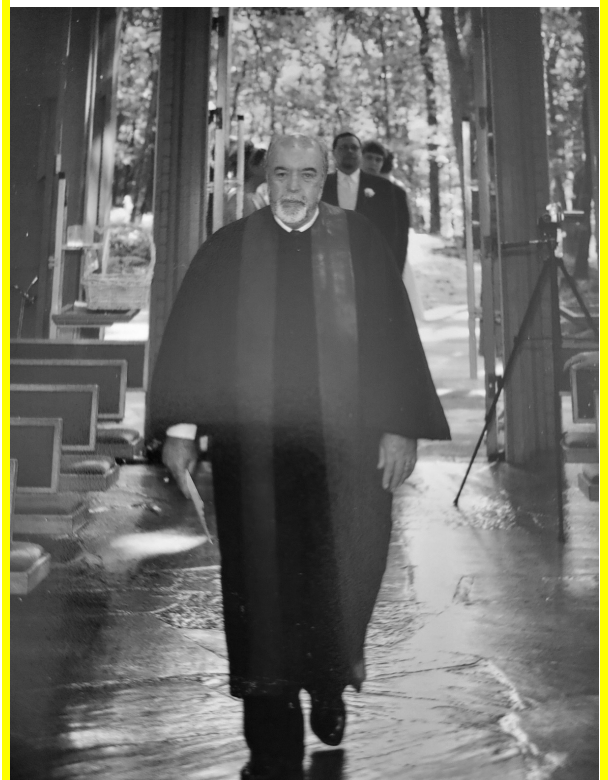
I hope that everyone whose life was touched by this great man will honor his memory by continuing his work in our community by caring for each person with whom we may come in contact.

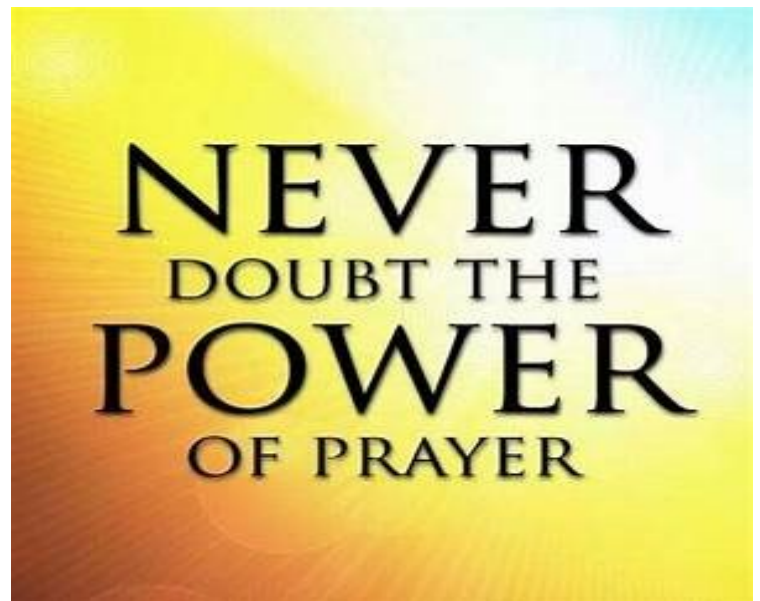

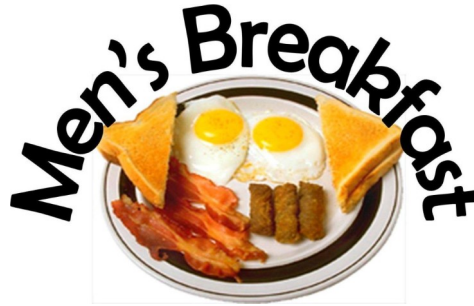
