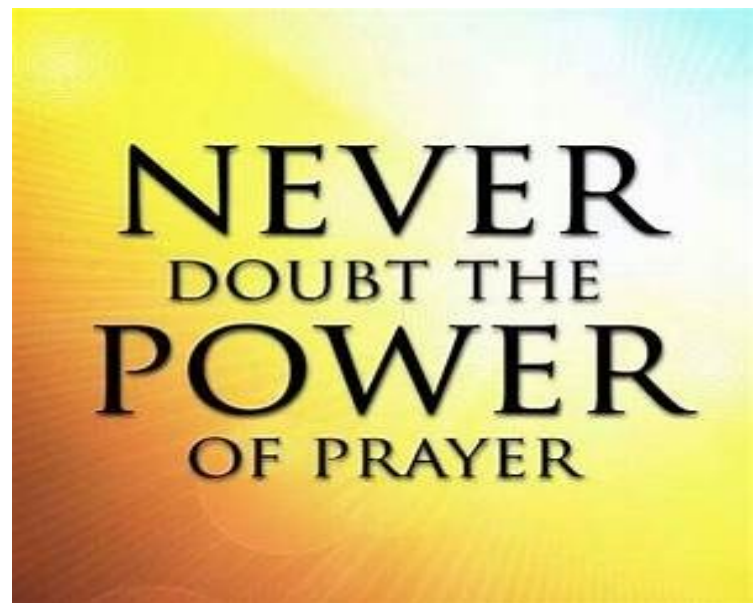

JULY OUTREACH



The Community of Christ Church at 108 Pawnee (right down the street from our church building) has what they call "Blessing Boxes" (wooden boxes filled with living essentials for un-housed or under-housed individuals).



These boxes contain food, clothing, hygiene necessities, etc., available to anyone that needs a hand up.

As part of our pledge to help the community of Clinton, we help supply these boxes with items.

For July Outreach we will be collecting ready to eat food items to place in the blessing boxes.

Most people in this situation do not have access to a can opener or to a microwave.

Examples of ready to eat food items are:

Tuna, canned fruit (pop top can), Vienna sausages, granola and protein bars, canned meat (pop top cans), Pop Tarts, cheese/peanut butter and crackers, etc.



We will have a collection site in the lobby of the church building.
