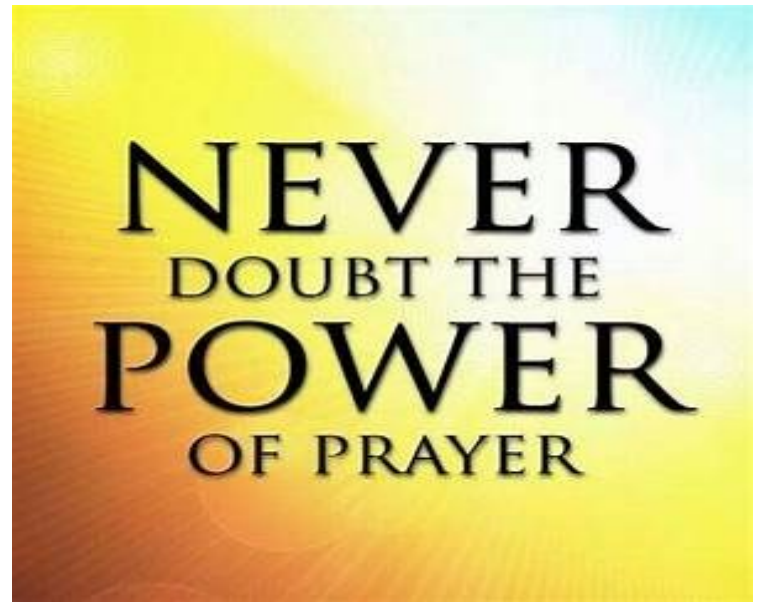

Reminder that Pastor Tim will be out for General Assembly on July 13th and 20th and retired Pastor David Maggi to help fill out pulpit.

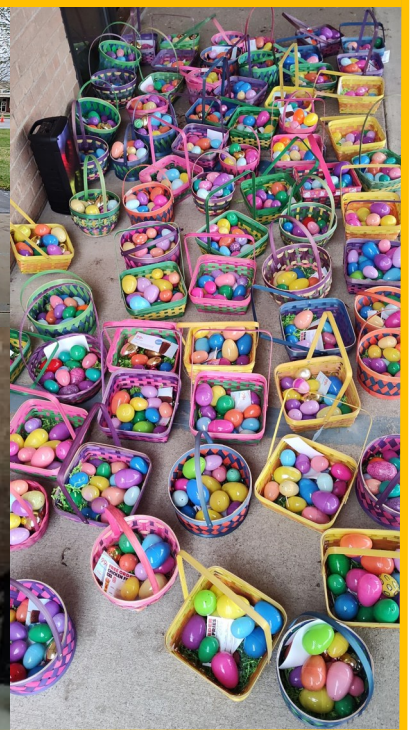
